1. Provide the zip code where cat was trapped. This helps us gather statistical information which is important when applying for grants.
2. If your cat has previously been microchipped, provide the microchip number, otherwise leave blank.
3. Complete Pet's Name if your cat has a name. If you are colony caretaker managing different colonies, we recommend that the cat's name be a "generic" location that you will recognize so you to know where the cat should be returned to if the cat is turned in to HHS. Otherwise, leave blank. If you do not know the cat's age or weight, leave blank.
4. Complete "Color" (of cat) e.g. black/white, black, gray tabby, orange tabby (though "tabby" is a coat pattern).
5. Description/Breed – generally Domestic Shorthair (DSH), Domestic Medium Hair (DMH), etc. Include any other distinct features. ("Domestic" refers to a cat of mixed ancestry.)
6. **YOUR (owner) information** should be **ACCURATE AND COMPLETE**. This helps to ensure that you can be contacted if anyone finds your cat. Address should be a mailing address. Do not use a business address unless you are the owner of the business.
7. An email address is highly recommended for registration into the Found Animals Registry. This is a free service and will ultimately help reunite owners and cats faster.
8. Owner (feeder, caregiver) must **SIGN** form unless signee has legal authority to represent the owner.
9. Date the form.
